STANDARDS OF CONDUCT



Liberty Christian Academy provides an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development for young people who may not be mature Christians. A standard of conduct based on the following biblical imperatives is necessary to provide such an environment. All of the activities of the Christian must be subordinated to the glory of God who indwells us (1 Cor. 8:9, 12-13; 10:32). The Christian will endeavor to avoid practices which cause the loss of sensitivity to the spiritual needs of people and loss of the Christian's physical, mental, or spiritual well-being (1 Cor. 9:27).

A sense of the need for spiritual growth in the light of these principles has led Liberty to adopt the following standards which are believed to be conducive to the environment that will best promote the spiritual welfare of our students.

1. Refrain from participating in worldly activities such as swearing, indecent language, smoking, possession or use of liquor, drugs, tobacco, involvement in the occult, gambling, stealing, pornography, sensual dancing, premarital sex or other immoral perversions, and involvement (per LCA's written music policy- see handbook) in rock and roll, rap, hip-hop, or other inappropriate music and/or media.
2. Refrain from harassment, fighting, violence, or threats of any kind regardless of provocation; and public disruptions of any kind.
3. Be respectful and obedient to their teachers, principals, and other school officials without reservation.
4. Maintain Christian standards in courtesy, kindness, honesty, morality, and modest attire.

Students are expected to abide by these standards throughout their enrollment at Liberty. Students found to be out of harmony with the Academy's ideals, any student who makes violent threats, or any student who has been arrested by authorities will be subject to administrative withdrawal. In this atmosphere of definite and positive Christian standards of conduct, good scholastic planning, and genuine personal interest between faculty and students, there is great opportunity for the development of strong Christian character and leadership.
